GIFT AID.

1. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax equal to the tax that the Friends reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1. you donate).

2. Please notify the Friends if you change your name or address.

3. You can cancel the Gift Aid donation at any time by notifying the Friends - it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.

4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income or capital gains equal to the tax that the Friends reclaim, you can cancel your Gift Aid declaration (see note 3).

5. If you pay at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.

6. The Inland Revenue requires that all payments are made in a variable form i.e. Standing Order, Cheque, Envelopes and that receipts are given and retained.
